

ontinuing the successful formula of the first four editions, the *Generations Rally 2026* will once again be based in a single hotel. The St Pierre Country Club, with history dating back to 1065 and ties to King Henry V and the crown jewels, promises a warm welcome. Close to Chepstow, between Cardiff and Bristol, it provides the perfect hub for us to explore beautiful scenery and fantastic driving roads in every direction.

To the North lie the Wye Valley, The Forest of Dean, Hereford and the Malverns, while across the River Severn the lanes of Gloucestershire lead us into the Cotswolds Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty. To the West, we are almost spoilt for choice with all the rallying territory that South and Mid Wales have to offer.

Military training areas, airfields and private estates will provide our playground for special tests, the roads driven in between will be equally challenging and spectacular, including a Top Gear favourite road in the heart of the Brecon Beacons.

Activities will commence on Friday morning with the usual pre-event formalities of Scrutineering and Signing-On. After a light lunch and introductory briefing, the event starts with a full afternoon's rallying close to Chepstow that will allow newcomers to familiarise themselves with the concepts of Tests and Regularity Sections. The day will conclude with a Welcome Dinner, providing a convivial environment to share hints, experiences and maybe the odd mishap with fellow competitors, the more experienced crews perhaps formulating their game plan for the rest of the weekend.

Saturday will see us head North West as far as Bannau Brycheiniog and beyond for a full day of rallying through the beautiful landscapes of the Wye Valley and Mid Wales. The Regularities and Tests will gradually become more challenging as the day progresses and as crews become acquainted with the techniques required. Returning to

Chepstow in the late afternoon, drinks and dinner will again be a great time to discuss the day's achievements or otherwise.

Sunday will feature a full final morning of competition with enough challenges to shape the final leaderboard. A late lunch and an afternoon prize-giving will then allow for a return home at a reasonable time - after what we are sure will have been another terrific introduction of our hobby to the next generation.

ligible Crew: Each crew should consist of members of two distinct Generations - ideally from the same family. All crew members must be at least 12 years old at the time of the event. Any crew member under the age of 18 may only form a crew with their parent or legal guardian.

Eligible Cars: Cars of a specification produced before 31st December 1985. There will be a separate classification for cars of a specification produced before 31st December 1945. Please check with us if you are not sure if your car is eligible.

Competition: There will be Regularity Sections each day on twisty but quiet minor roads. Special Tests will also take place throughout the event on private land, which can include farm tracks and large car parks.

Roads used: Some of the most scenic roads in the area can be

bumpy so low-slung cars may need to be driven with care, but we will avoid rough, potholed and unsurfaced roads as much as possible.

Hospitality: Our high-class accommodation will also be the venue for dinner each evening, and for a Prize-giving Gala Lunch on the final day.

Navigation: The rally navigation will utilise a tulip Road Book with simple Regularities and Tests to start with, getting a little more complicated as the event progresses. Some sections will require straight-forward map reading using map extracts that will be provided in the Road Book.

Tuition will be given before the start for crews that haven't taken part in this type of rallying before, and Rally the Globe mentor teams will be on hand throughout the event to help with any queries.
