With five successful editions behind us, the *Generations Rally* in 2027 will again be based in a single hotel. Slaley Hall Hotel, Spa and Golf Resort, near Hexham, promises a warm Northumbrian welcome and will serve as the perfect hub for us to sample as much of the ruggedly beautiful scenery and as many of the amazing driving roads as we can fit into the event's second visit to the North East of England.



Based in the heart of Northumberland and Hadrian's Wall Country, Slaley Hall allows us to go in every direction over the course of the weekend. We will head North to the Cheviot Hills, West along the Tyne Valleys and across the Pennines as far as Westmorland and even Cumberland, and South into County Durham and the edge of Yorkshire.

Castles, stately homes, military training areas, airfields, farmyards and private estates will provide our playground for special tests, the roads linking them together will provide just as much fun.

Event activities get under way with Scrutineering and Signing-on on Friday morning although there will also be a limited opportunity to Scrutineer on Thursday afternoon. After a light lunch and introductory briefing, the rallying begins in earnest with an afternoon's competition that will allow newcomers to acquaint themselves with the principles of Tests and Regularity Sections. Back at Slaley Hall, the day concludes with a Welcome Dinner, offering the ideal opportunity to share hints, experiences and maybe the odd tale of woe with fellow competitors.

Saturday will be a full day of rallying, with the Regularities and Tests steadily getting a little more taxing as the day progresses and as crews begin to get into the groove or remember what they had forgotten since last year! Returning to Slaley Hall in the late afternoon, will allow plenty of time to discuss the day's highs and lows over

a drink in the bar and then dinner with friends old and new.

Sunday will feature a full final morning with enough competition for crews to work their way up (or down!) the final leaderboard. The weekend will be rounded off with a late lunch and afternoon prize-giving, which will allow a return home at a sensible hour – after what we are sure will have been another terrific introduction of our hobby to the next generation.

Eligible Crew: Each crew should consist of members of two distinct generations – ideally from the same family. All crew members must be at least 12 years old at the time of the event. Any crew member under the age of 18 may only form a crew with their parent or legal guardian.

Eligible Cars: Cars of a specification produced before 31st December 1985. There will be a separate classification for cars of a specification produced before 31st December 1945. Please check with us if you are not sure if your car is eligible.

Competition: There will be Regularity Sections each day on twisty but quiet minor roads. Special Tests will also take place throughout the event on private land, which can include farm tracks, large car parks, estate roads, etc.

Roads used: Some of the most scenic roads in the area can be bumpy so low-slung cars may need to be driven with care, but we will avoid rough, badly potholed and unsurfaced roads as much as possible.

Hospitality: Our comfortable accommodation sat in extensive grounds will also be the venue for dinner each evening, and for a Prize-giving Gala Lunch on the final day.

Navigation: The rally navigation will utilise a tulip Road Book with simple Regularities and Tests to start with, getting a little more complicated as the event progresses. Some sections will require straight-forward map reading using map extracts that will be provided in the Road Book. Tuition will be given before the start for crews that haven't taken part in this type of rallying before, and *Rally the Globe* mentor teams will be on hand throughout the event to help with any queries.
